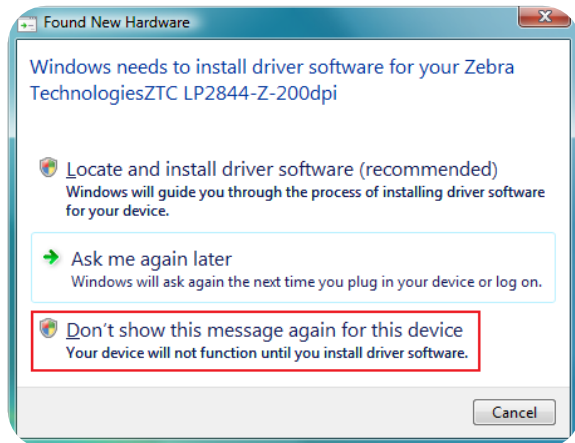


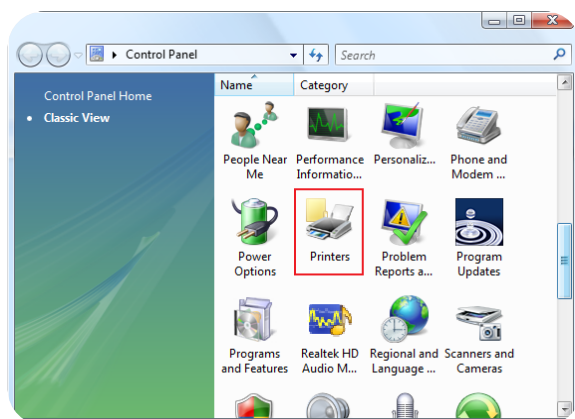
ZEBRA TLP LABEL PRINTER SETUP GUIDE – VISTA



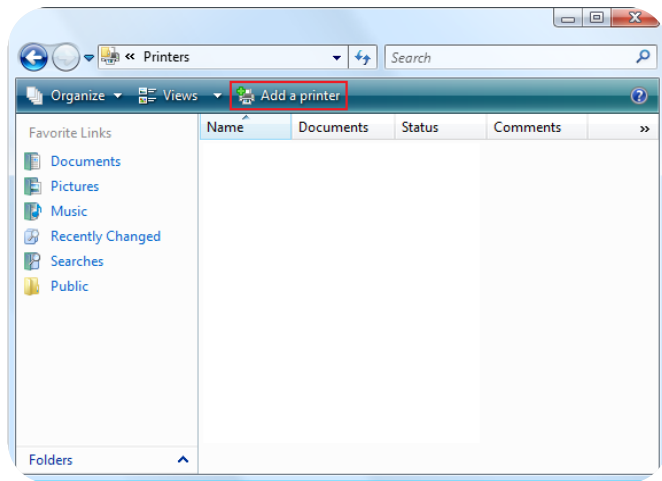
1. Have PC turned on, ensuring no programs are running.
2. Plug power into ZEBRA TLP and turn on by holding the round green button.
3. Plug USB lead into available USB port.
4. Vista will detect the device and prompt for further action (left)
5. Select “ Don't show this message again for this device”



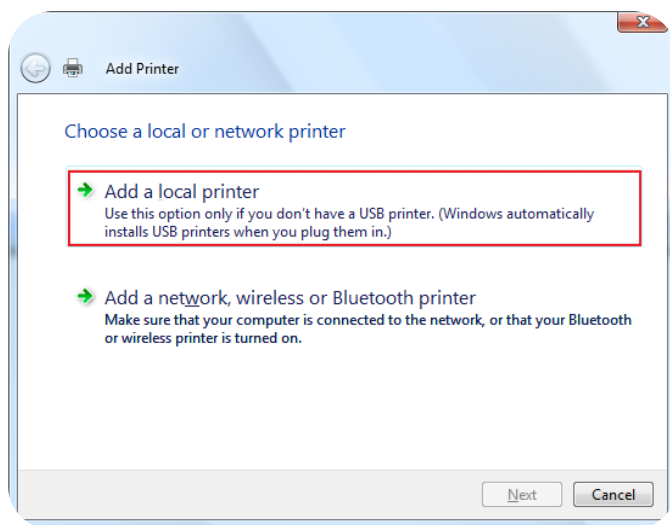
6. Now you will be looking at a clear desktop. Click Start, then control panel.



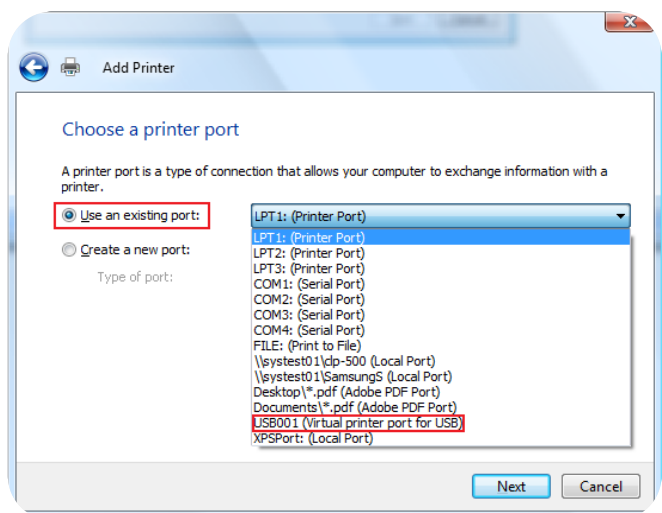
7. Now in control panel, click Printers



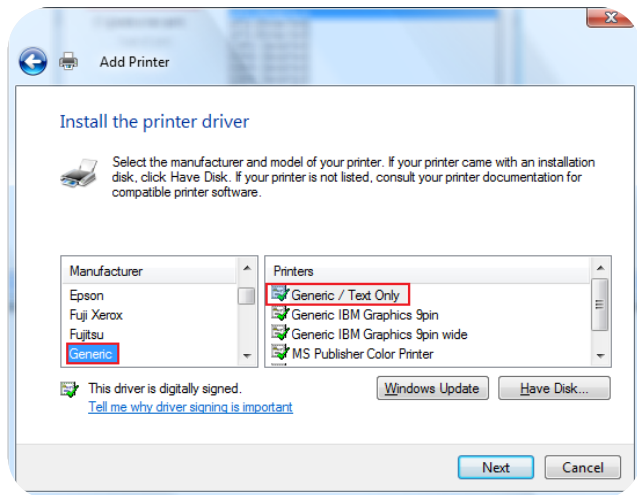
8. Now in the printer dialogue, select the “Add a printer” button.



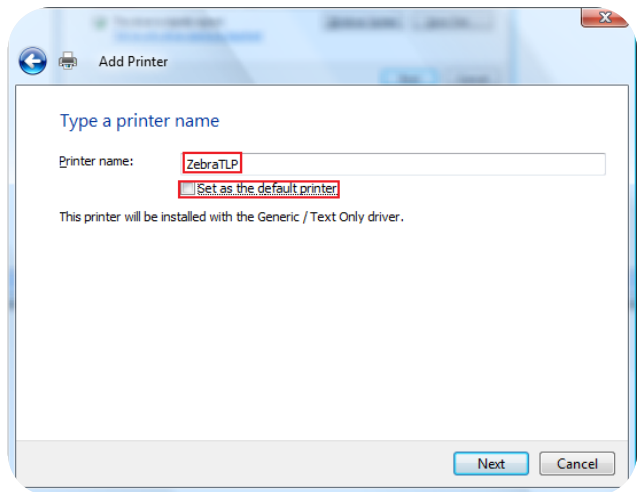
9. The Add printer option will appear.
10. Simply select the “Add a local printer” option.
11. Then click next.



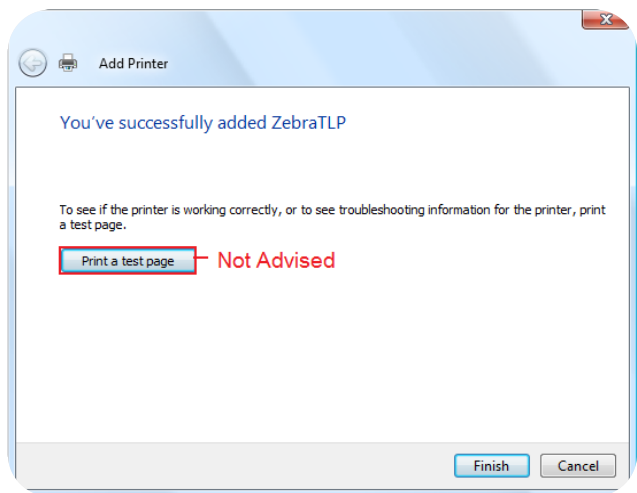
10. You will now be looking at the printer selection pane.
11. Ensure that “Use an existing port” is selected.
12. Select the USB (Virtual Printer Port for USB) in the port selection box (right)
13. Click Next.



14. You will now see two selection boxes, Manufacturer (left) & Printer Model (Right)
15. Select GENERIC in the left selection box.
16. Select GENERIC/PLAIN TEXT in the right selection box.
17. Click Next.



18. You will now be required to give the Printer a name. In the name field enter **ZebraTLP** exactly.
19. Also ensure that the printer is 'not' the default printer.
20. Click Next.



21. You will now see the save successful dialogue.
22. **ADVICE:** do not print test page, as this will print several labels.
23. Installation complete.
